TERRAFRICA LEVERAGING FUND (TLF)

The TerrAfrica Leveraging Fund (TLF) provides a flexible financing mechanism to support activities that have the potential for scaling up sustainable land and water management (SLWM) in Sub-Saharan Africa (SSA) countries, under the TerrAfrica Program.

TLF SUPPORT MECHANISM

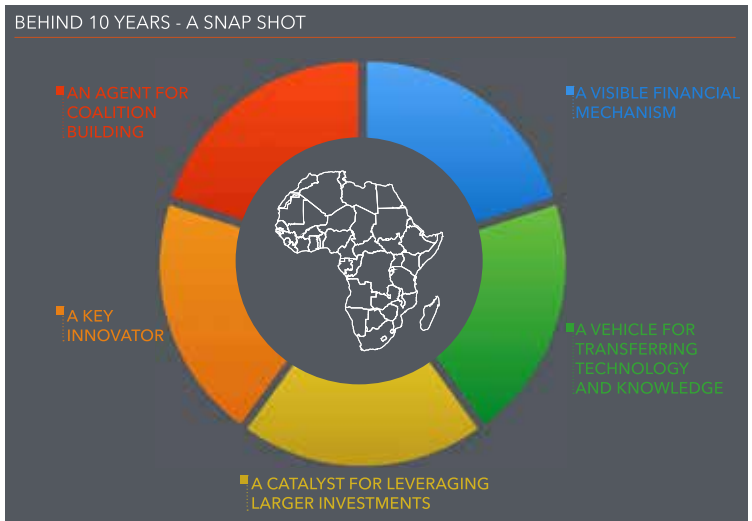
- Support to implement priorities established by the TerrAfrica Executive Committee (TAEC) and the Strategic Business Planning Framework.
- Support to targeted activities typically between US\$10,000 and US\$350,000
- Support to strategic key products from the TerrAfrica program activity lines.



THE TERRAFRICA PROGRAM

TerrAfrica is an Africa based and Africa-led partnership of Sub-Saharan countries and partners including Regional Economic Communities (RECs), UN bodies, international organizations, EU, bilaterals, and civil society organizations. Created in 2005, it has been at the forefront of assisting African countries to reverse land degradation and build resilience by adopting policies and programs that promote sustainable land and water management (SLWM) practices under a landscape approach.

The TerrAfrica Secretariat is hosted by the NEPAD Planning and Coordinating Agency (NPCA) through TLF support.

TLF CONTRIBUTIONS



First Generation Investment Program

US\$1.8 billion Strategic Investment Program (SIP) for SLM to support 36 projects in 26 countries.

Country level support examples: Integrated Watershed Management, SLWM for Farmers' Incomes, SLWM to Mitigate Risks from Floods,

Piloting Private Sector Partnership, Land Restoration from gully erosion, Sustainable Landscape Management, Scaling up Tree Based Ecosystem Approaches, Natural Resources Management and Adaptive livelihoods and more.

TLF FUNDING

Established in 2009, this is Multi-donor trust fund with total contribution of US\$24.1 million - from the European Union (US\$ 13.3 million), the Netherlands (US\$ 6.0 million) and Norway (US\$4.7 million).
